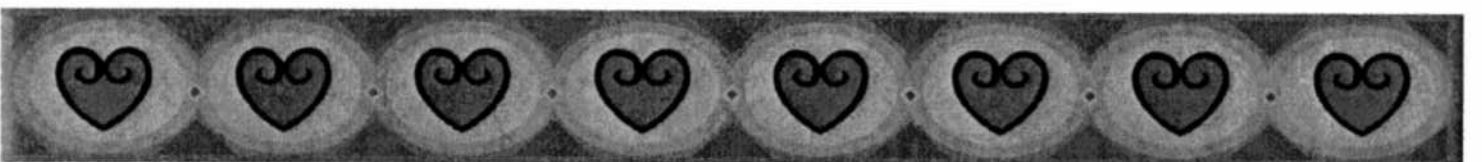
**High School Book Club** Wed. Feb. 8, 4-5 pm
