Dear parents,

I would like to thank all of the parents who attended our new family coffee session this morning. I will be sharing some notes on our small meeting for those who were unable to attend and would like to read through them later today.

I have some wonderful news to share. Yesterday Father Mike and I accepted a check presented to St. Joan of Arc Parish School on behalf of the Marcus Corporation and The Tim Cup Invitational (Tim and Julie Lamont). This donation, in the amount of \$15,000, will be used to purchase a new portable computer classroom on wheels. This will include 25 brand new laptop computers and a wheeling charging station so any classroom may become a computer lab. I am extremely excited to place this order and so very thankful for this wonderful gift. Thanks be to God (and his angels here on Earth)!

Next week Wednesday is picture day. We will continue the tradition of allowing students to be out of uniform to dress up for the picture day. Please remember that students will wear their dress up clothes all day at school (including to lunch and recess) and you may want to send different shoes or other items to be activity and weather appropriate.

I would like to inform/remind all parents of our traffic pattern for drop off and pick up of students. We ask all parents to enter the parking lot from the north drive and exit through the south drive. This keeps all traffic flowing in one direction which reduced the safety risks for those crossing. Upon my return, crossing guards will also be trained to move to new posts in order to cover more areas in the parking lot with our growing amount of traffic. Please keep your eyes peeled for information about Home and School's Fun Pasta fundraiser. The fundraiser will run for 2 weeks in October.

Please also remember as you turn in hot lunch order forms that a separate form needs to be filled out for each child in order for accurate food quantities to be ordered.
